Week 1 (6/18 – 6/22)	Scooter's Jungle	6/20 (Wednesday)

Heritage Park tells the stories of the past: the Tongva/Gabrielino Indians and their domed-shaped dwellings; the railroad exhibits feature the Santa Fe Railway Depot, tracks, signals and a steam locomotive. Children can also climb into the cab of a locomotive, visit the tank house and the carriage barn, pump water from the well - a good experience in old times.
